

## Community Support Internship

This placement would offer students the opportunity to work within our Community Integration Manager (CIM) team and gain direct experience providing therapeutic community support to clients in treatment at our practice. Students could be involved in a number of individual, group and team based activities as part of this training experience.

Placements may include the following:

- Working individually or with one of our CIMs to provide one on one support to clientele.
- Co-facilitation or facilitation of pro-social, life/relationship skill building group programming. Such groups might include:
  - Recreational Program
  - Horticultural Program
  - Volunteer Program
  - Music Program
- Co-facilitation or facilitation of pro-social, life/relationship skill building programming within a residential setting at our Healthy Homes.
- Assisting in the delivery of Aboriginal Traditional support and healing group programming.
- Special projects, such as developing/enhancing community connections and resources, and research.
- Attending team meetings and participating in clinical case conferences.

Practicum placements can be individualized based on the interests, skills and qualities of each student.
